Objective

Scope of the MoU

1. Educational Exchange

- Faculty members from both colleges will engage in exchange programs to share expertise, collaborate on research, and enhance teaching methodologies.

2. Cultural and Co-curricular Collaborations

- The two colleges will organize joint cultural events, fostering cultural diversity and promoting the arts.
- Joint participation in co-curricular activities such as sports, debates, quizzes, and talent exhibitions will be encouraged.

3. Career Counseling and Skill Development


- Both institutions will jointly organize workshops, career counseling sessions, and skill development seminars aimed at guiding students towards future careers and enhancing employability.

Implementation and Terms

1. Duration

This MoU is valid for a period of one year from the date of signing. It may be renewed or extended by mutual consent.

2. Amendments

Any amendments to this MoU must be made in writing and agreed upon by both parties.

3. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU with a written notice of three (3) months.

4. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising during the execution of this MoU shall be resolved through arbitration, with one representative nominated by each college and a mutually agreed-upon third party.
